About the project

Participants will become ambassadors of sustainability. They will also learn how to use modern tools of communication to support, disseminate, promote values in the fight against Climate Change.

ACCOMMODATION

Centro Don Orione – Velletri

All participants will be accommodated in Centro Don Orione in double/triple/quadruple rooms (shared bathrooms). All meals during the activity period are covered and will be available at the accommodation.

Food at the accommodation can accommodate vegetarians, vegans, gluten and lactose intolerance (if you have celiac disease or any other allergies please inform us so that we can discuss cross-contamination with the staff).

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT



The project budget covers all costs for accommodation and for 3 meals per day. Travel costs (from your house to the venue) will be reimbursed up to a maximum of 275€ per participant.

The arrival and departure days of the Youth Exchange are the 8th and 15th of June: you can extend your stay in Italy up to 2 extra days outside the project and still be eligible for your travel reimbursement.

Please remember that accommodation or food for the extra days will not be covered.

Keep all your tickets, receipts, reservations, and boarding pass in order for us to be able to reimburse you! Reimbursement will be done only after all travel documents and payment proofs will be collected.
