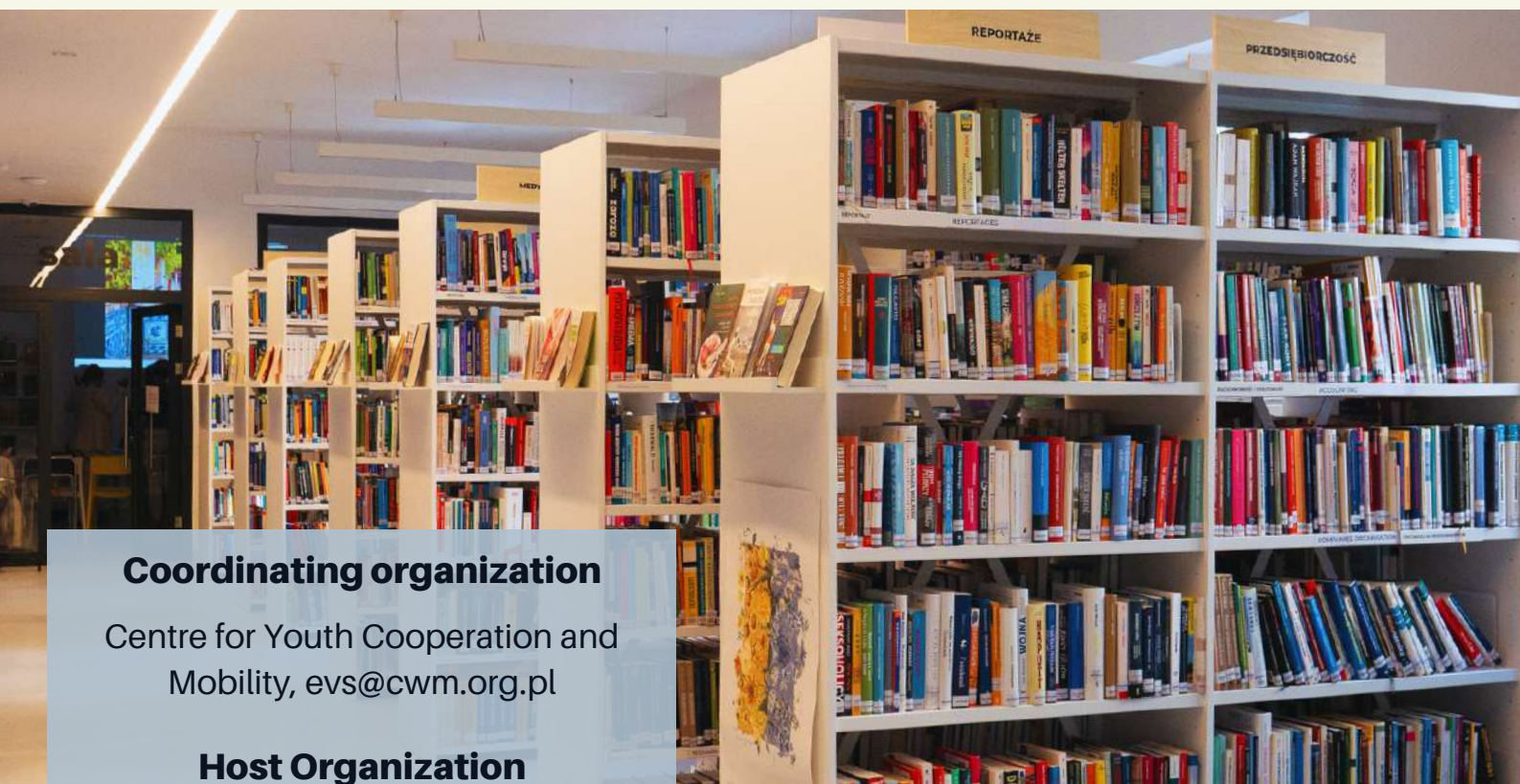

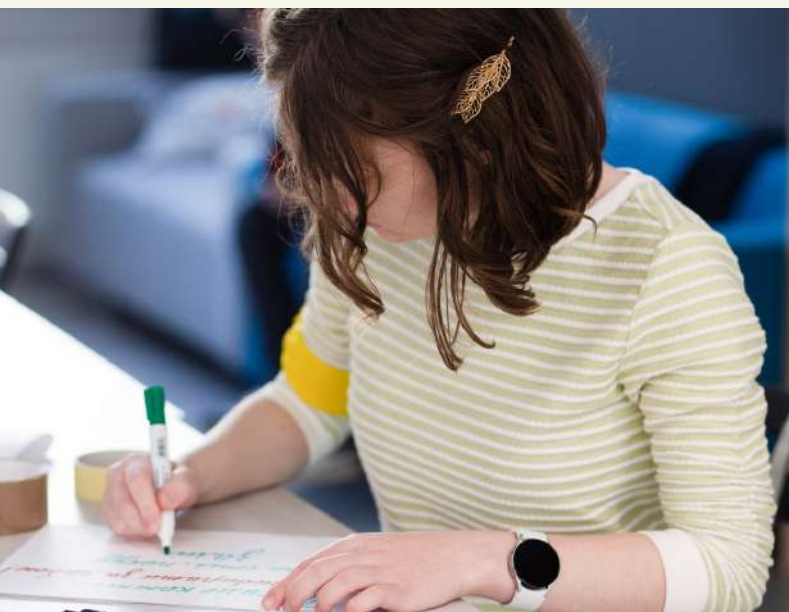
Library is a place full of books - but for sure it is not boring! As Public Libraries offer more than just books. They propose children's programs, workshops and many interesting events for local communities in various ways. And for this purpose they need the support of volunteers, to make their offer more valuable and interesting.

# WHAT WILL YOU DO?



The volunteer will support employers of the library in their daily tasks. It includes helping with:

- working with guests;
- preparing and conducting different activities for groups of children/ youth /adults;
- keeping materials and space in good shape; working with books, CDs, and other library materials;
- typical librarian's work: labeling; creating displays, planning and presenting programs; books and shelves maintaining;
- organizing events and workshops of the coordinating organization Centre for Youth Cooperation and Mobility;
- preparing and leading at least one English conversation workshop per week;
- preparing and leading presentations about your country, at least 2 times in different branches of Gdynia's Public Library.



# WHO ARE WE?

The library in Gdynia consists of 20 branches, which are situated in different districts of the city. Often the library may be the only cultural institution in the neighbourhood.

Depending on the district, where the libraries' departments are located, our main actions concern groups of people socially and culturally excluded - in terms of not equal access to social and cultural goods, where society is rather poor (in both financial and cultural way, where dominates passiveness among people).



Therefore we prepare workshops with local artists and social workers, reading aloud, making illustrations with kids, lessons how to use book resources, how to search information in internet and books, English lessons for young and older people - equalizing opportunities, dancing workshops, theater workshops, photo workshops, art workshops.

# WHO CAN APPLY?

We are looking for 1 volunteer who will be:

- communicative and open for new experiences;
- creative and inventive;
- it is welcome if the volunteer has basic English language skills and is willing to study Polish;
- interested in methods of active education, open for people from other countries and cultures and willing to co-operate and work in group;
- open-minded.

We are searching for young people, who would contribute to the actions taken by the library and would like to develop his/her personality.

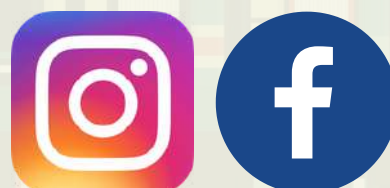
Being interested in literature and librarian's tasks or some artistic skills would be a positive asset taken into consideration during the recruitment process.
