Our main aim is to help children, youth, elders and families, who are in tough living situation.

Our Association works in Gdynia city, Chylonia district, which is one of the oldest settlements in the city. Many families live there in a very difficult conditions, detached from the cultural opportunities as well as social support.

We help these families by organizing a safe, after-school place for children and young people to spend time and grow, as well as to organize activities directed to seniors, young mothers and entire families.

Our regular activities include running the socio-therapeutic common -room (form of therapy addressed to children and adolescents with various disorders and difficulties in psychosocial functioning) and a senior club. Twice a year we also organize camps for children. Moreover we organize actions animating the local community, like festivals and family events.

We cooperate with the parish of St. Nicolaus in Gdynia, and our building is located on its premises. Christian values such as love, goodness, openness and willingness to help those who are in need are important to us. But the approach to the religion and faith of our beneficiaries, employees and volunteers is not important to us.

VOLUNTEER'S ROLE & TASKS

Volunteers work as assistance to educators of children and in youth club. The volunteers assist in animating free time activities, help children in homework, run workshops of own idea for children, youth or seniors.

The examples of tasks:

- helping children with their homework,
 - animating free time activities,
 - carrying out classes / workshops for the children (e.g. language training, music workshops, cooking etc.)
 - assisting in socio-therapeutic activities,
 - creating social projects in cooperation with the secondary school students,
 - supporting the organization of large events for local community (e.g. festives, charity actions) - supporting the tutors during youth camps
- Detailed tasks will be decided with the volunteer according to his/her skills and interests.

You will have a chance to learn and get experience in:

- working with children and youth, especially those with special needs,
- running own workshops;
- organizing social actions for local community,
- assisting socio-therapy activities,

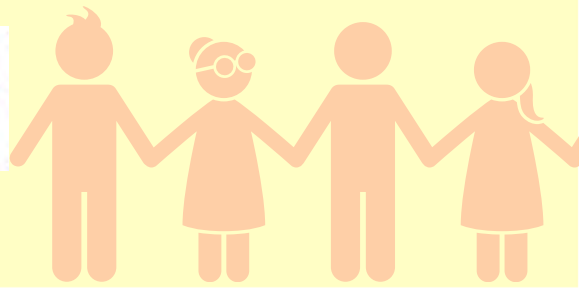
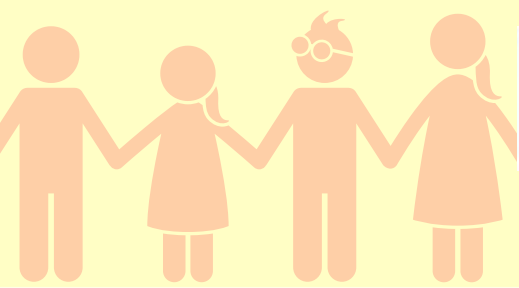
